

## Annual Report

I am indeed very glad to present the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Report of Spring Valley School for the academic year 2018-19. This academic year was supposed to begin on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2018, but unfortunately due to the spread and threat of Nipah virus and the order from the Collector, the school reopened only on 12.06.2018.

The total strength of the school is 315. There are 18 teaching staff and 6 supporting staff.

Our Sr.Principal Prof.Unnikrishnan Nambeesan resigned in March after his 17 years of service and Ms.Shyni took charge as Principal. After a long service of 25 years, Mr.Venugopala Panicker, our teacher in Malayalam also resigned in March 2018. Ms.Anupriya M T took charge as Physics teacher in July and resigned in the month of August. Ms. Bindu, Social Science teacher also resigned as she got job in govt. sector. Ms.Vismaya, English teacher also resigned and so Ms.Rosa V George was appointed as teacher in English.
